

EXPLORING ARTH, RAJNEETI, AND DARSHAN IN INDIAN KNOWLEDGE TRADITIONS

Course Details

This certificate course delves into the multifaceted contributions of ancient Indian economic thought, political philosophy, and statecraft. To understand the philosophical foundations of Arth (meaning and economy), Rajneeti (ethical governance), and Darshan (philosophy and vision) through the Indian Knowledge System, development, and governance using the Economy of Philosophy framework, this course will help in thinking and analyzing the reinterpretation of Economy, Rajneeti, and social terms. Through an interdisciplinary approach, the course explores Arthashastra and its relevance to contemporary economic and political contexts. This is also a method for thinking outside the box in society, considering time and situation.

Course Objective and Outline

- Understand the Indian concept of Arth as ethical, relational, and spiritual wealth—not just material.
- Analyze governance (Rajneeti) through the lens of Dharma and Indian Knowledge Systems.
- Explore how Indian philosophical traditions (Darshan) shape economy, society, and public policy.
- Apply the Economy of Philosophy framework to redefine development, wealth, and sustainability.

About the Instructor

Alok K. Dwivedi, Ph.D., is a young philosopher who is working on creating a value system for the society which would be based on holistic education. His major focus is on finding the practical value of philosophy. In his work, "Economy of Philosophy", he established the philosophical meaning of "Arth" & established its connection with economical parameters. He also started working on two very interesting projects: Concept of Ramatva & Natural World Order, where he wants to establish a connection between social theory based on freedom & creativity to natural evolution parameters. This course is part of the aforementioned project, Concept of Ramatva, which tries to identify the duty of the individuals according to their self-understanding & realization. His field of research includes Axiology, Indian Ethics, Administrative Ethics, Indian Philosophy, Prosperity through Philosophy, Idea of Ramatva, & New Natural World Order.
